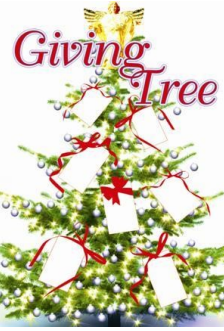


## ANNOUNCEMENTS AND PRAISE
