#### Prayer of the Day:

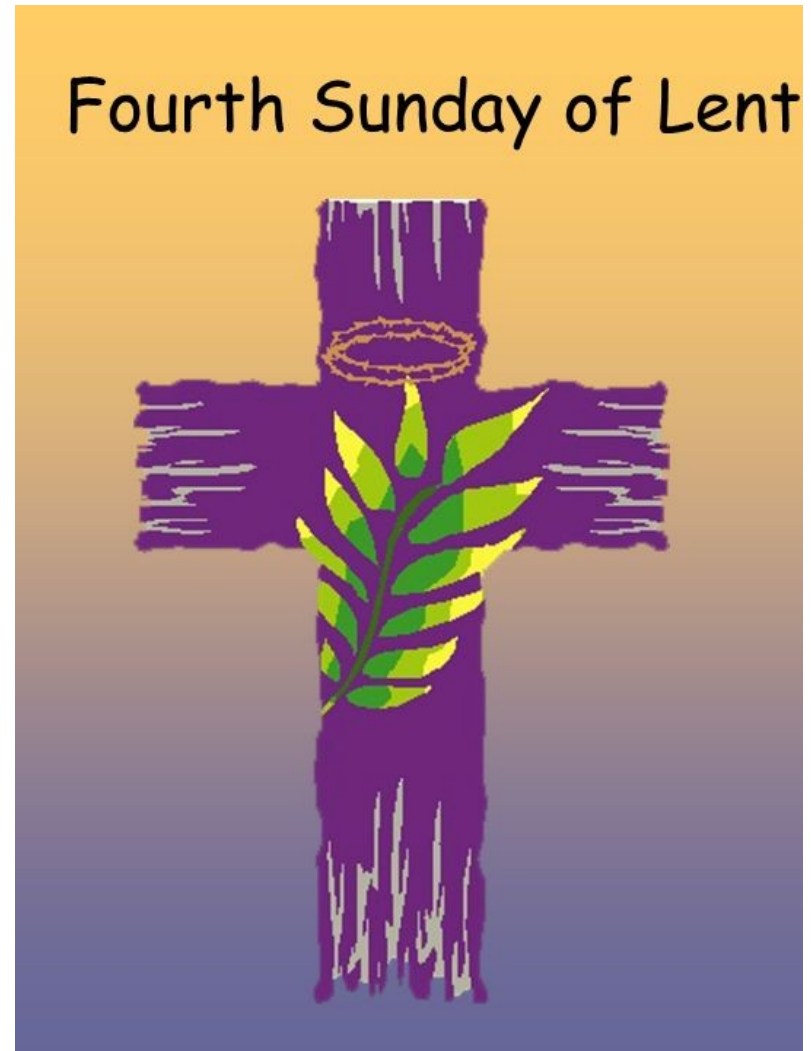
